INDEPENDENCE DAY

Cultural programme of the teacher trainees entertained everyone.

TREE PLANTING DAY

On 11.09.2018, Tree Planting Day was celebrated in District Institute of Education and Training, Perundurai. SUICIDE PREVENTION WEEK

Suicide Prevention Week was observed in DIET, Perundurai on 14.09.18 in order to create awareness among students regarding suicidal attempts prevailing throughout and also about the measures to prevent them. Principal, Staff members and Students of DIET, Perundurai participated in this event. Angel Caroline of I year welcomed the gathering. The event was presided over by the respected Principal Mr.N.Lakshminarasimhan who in his address emphasized issues related to Mental Health by citing his life experiences. Dr. Prem Nivaz who followed next stressed the importance of happiness in everyone's life. He added that we should accept failures and sufferings in

the same way as we approach victory and happiness as we gain experiences and self-confidence through them. By quoting the reputed Novelist Earnest Hemingway who in spite of his intelligence ended his life by committing suicide, he insisted that one should be courageous enough to face things of any sort in his life.



Mr.Rajaiah, Vice-Principal in his address cited that in most of the cases stress paves way for suicide and he suggested ways to overcome it. Mr. Xavier, Senior Lecturer, emphasized that one's ego induces him to attempt suicide. Afterward, a short drama on Suicidal attempts, its consequences and preventive measures was performed by Dhanvadhiri College Students. Mr.N.Jayaprakash, Resource person stated that this day has been observed from 1898 and Tamilnadu is placed second in suicidal attempts. He also in his address insisted that people suffer from mental illness which is due to stress, fear and anxiety etc., Ms.P.Susila of Dhanvadhri Nursing College addressed on 'Let us join our hands to prevent suicides'. Mr.Anburaj, Lecturer, gave the feedback.



SCOUTS AND GUIDE TRAINING

Following the inauguration, health examination was done for all the students. Dental problems, ophthalmic complaints, Anaemia and other health issues were attended, screened and treated by the

concerned doctors. The camp was highly beneficial for the students to diagnose their health related problems and to get treated.



FIELD TRIP

A Field Trip was organized by DIET Perundurai, Erode, on 05.04.2019 for Student teachers. First and second year student teachers and Lecturers enthusiastically made a visit to important places which included Regional Science Centre, Coimbatore, G. D. Naidu Museum, Park and Maruthamalai Temple. Visiting Science Centre, Coimbatore was a great opportunity for the teacher trainees to explore and experience the various aspects of science in a fun manner. Many science concepts were explained through interactive exhibits, working models and presentations. They acquired various information through visiting various sections such as how things work, Fun science gallery, Textile gallery, Science Park, 3D Science Theatre and Temporary exhibition hall. Each section provided them a chance for hands on experience. Students spent quality time at the Planetarium watching a show on the solar system.



Next, G.D.Naidu museum was visited. An impressive collection of various electronic gadgets and scientific devices and gadgets of olden period to recent period impressed the student teachers. Various kinds of film cameras, projection TVs, ball point pens, floppy disks, calculators, type writers, systems, printers, and various interesting equipments were exhibited. After having an entertaining time in a park, Maruthamalai temple was visited. This field trip was educative and enjoyable to the students.



TET TRAINING
